## What do you think of the new NYPD parade permit regulation?

It should apply to other groups too, like Strollercise, morning commuters, etc. But I do which Critical Mass would stop endangering other cyclists by making people think ALL cyclists are inconsiderate. I witnessed one Sunday Critical Mass in Paris this summer, led by police on skates, skateboards and bicycles, with police also interspersed in the crowd. Motorists were happy to stop, and the atmosphere was one of fun and civility. Why can't that happen in New York?

## How can the City improve bicycling conditions?

My worst run-ins and near-misses in NY have been with pedestrians and with MTA busses. A campaign to make ALL elements in city traffic aware of their responsibility to act civily and be considerate of others would help a lot.

Paving potholed streets would help too. As would more bike lanes, perhaps with a DOUBLE line separating them from traffic. Anything that encourages more people to bicycle and fewer to drive will make improve conditions. New York could be one of the "greenest" cities on earth if it would encourage self-propelled transportation, and maybe rooftop gardens like Chicago has.
